(CERTIFICATE)

WHEREAS:

- A. Eskay Creek Mining Ltd. proposes to construct, operate, and decommission the Eskay Creek Revitalization Project (the Project) described in Schedule A to this Certificate.
- B. On November 18, 2022, the chief executive assessment officer of the Environmental Assessment Office published a notice of decision under Section 18(1)(a) of the Act stating that the Project would be considered under Section 19 of the Act.
- C. On May 30, 2025, the revised Application was accepted under Section 27(4) of the Act and by the Tahltan Central Government as referred to in Section 7.35 of the Declaration Act Consent Decision-Making Agreement for Eskay Creek Project.

- D. Compliance with this Certificate, including its conditions, will be monitored by the staff of the Environmental Assessment Office and others who have been authorized to inspect under the Act.
- E. On January 16, 2026, pursuant to Section 29(1) of the Act, the chief executive assessment officer referred the revised Application, the assessment report dated January 16, 2026, the proposed environmental assessment certificate, the chief executive assessment officer's recommendations, notification received from Nisga'a Nation indicating consent to issuing the certificate, the Tahltan Risk Assessment Report dated January 3, 2026, and the Decision Statement of Tahltan Central Government dated January 11, 2026, to the undersigned.
- F. The undersigned have considered the information identified in clause E.

NOW THEREFORE,

We issue this Environmental Assessment Certificate to Eskay Creek Mining Ltd. for the Project as described in the Certified Project Description (Schedule A), subject to the conditions set out in the Table of Conditions (Schedule B).

DURATION OF CERTIFICATE

For the purpose of Section 31(1) of the Act, the deadline is ten years from the date set out below.
