**AMENDMENT #1 (AMENDMENT)
TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATE #M26-01**

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 11, 2026, the Tahltan Central Government issued a Notice of Decision indicating its consent to the Eskay Creek Revitalization Project (the Project) proceeding.
- B. On January 26, 2026, the Minister of Environment and Parks and the Minister of Mining and Critical Minerals issued Environmental Assessment Certificate #M26-01 (Certificate) to Eskay Creek Mining Ltd.
- C. The Certificate authorized Eskay Creek Mining Ltd. to construct and operate the Project, an open-pit gold and silver mine located on and adjacent to the existing Eskay Creek Mine approximately 83 kilometres northwest of Stewart, British Columbia.
- D. On February 11, 2026, Eskay Creek Mining Ltd. requested to amend the Certificate under Section 32(1) of the Act to change the location and size of the Project's permanent camp, relocate the incinerator and create a waste sorting and maintenance area.
- E. On June 25, 2026, Tahltan Central Government provided a letter indicating their consent for proceeding with the requested amendment.

NOW THEREFORE,

I amend the Certificate as follows:

1. Subsection 2.1 under Project Components and Activities in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate is amended from:

Areas of Project disturbance are within the Project Development Area shown on Figure 2 and Figures 2-1 to 2-4. Use of, and modifications to, existing components of the existing Eskay Creek Mine and new components of the Project are within the Project Development Area as described below.

to:

Areas of Project disturbance within the Project Development Area are shown on Figure 2 and Figures 2-1 to 2-4. Use of, and modifications to, existing components of the existing Eskay Creek Mine and new components of the Project within the Project Development Area are described below.

2. Subparagraph 2.1 c) xii. under Project Components and Activities in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate is rescinded.
3. Subsection 2.9 under Project Components and Activities in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate is amended from:

Housing of the workforce independently in existing temporary camps or in third-party facilities outside of the Project Development Area.

to:

Housing of the workforce independently in a permanent camp within the Mine Camp Area shown on Figure 3, in existing temporary camps within the Project Development Area, or in existing third-party facilities outside of the Project Development Area and Mine Camp Area. The Mine Camp Area shown on Figure 3 includes a permanent camp with possible expansion to up to 500 bed units and mine dry and associated ancillary infrastructure.

4. Figure 3 in Attachment A of this Amendment is added to the List of Figures in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate.
5. Paragraph 20.3 a) under Condition 20 Human Health Management and Monitoring Plan in the Table of Conditions in Schedule B of the Certificate is amended from:

how the mitigation measures described in Table 5-1 in Appendix A-01 of the Application listed as being included in the Human Health Monitoring Program will be implemented;

to:

how the mitigation measures described in Table 5-1 in Appendix A-01 of the Application listed as being included in the Human Health Monitoring Program, excluding Mitigation ID #20.15, will be implemented;

6. Paragraph 20.3 c) under Condition 20 Human Health Management and Monitoring Plan in the Table of Conditions in Schedule B of the Certificate is amended from:

a program to test tissues of subsistence food animals (large mammals, small mammals, or birds that are consumed by people) that were killed incidentally or hunted in the Local Assessment Area (LAA) as defined in Figure 20.3-1 of the Application for POC concentrations;

to:

a program to test tissues of subsistence food animals (large mammals, small mammals, or birds that are consumed by people) that were killed incidentally or

hunted in the Human Health Risk Assessment Study Area as defined in Figure 20.3-2 of the Application for POC concentrations;

7. Paragraph 20.3 d) under Condition 20 Human Health Management and Monitoring Plan in the Table of Conditions in Schedule B of the Certificate is amended from:

monitoring of particulate matter (PM_{2.5}, PM₁₀ and NO₂) concentrations (outdoor and indoor) at all worker camps within the TMSF Area

to:

monitoring of particulate matter (PM_{2.5}, PM₁₀) and NO₂ concentrations at the worker camp within the Mine Camp Area
